Nearly all working parents agree that afterschool programs help them do their jobs and excite their children about learning. Yet more than 200,000 Massachusetts children are alone and unsupervised during the out-of-school time hours because their families cannot afford the cost of these important programs. 35 years ago, this underlying issue spurred the creation of For Kids Only Afterschool (FKO), when we first opened our doors in 1984 to care for five children in a church basement. Today, we enrich the lives of more than 1,600 children every year – providing them with a caring, safe place to go when school is out and unique opportunities to learn, love and grow.

While FKO enrollment levels are at an all-time high, there's more work to be done: today, hundreds of children across the communities we serve are waiting for the financial assistance they need to access quality out-of-school time enrichment programs.

To help children and families in need, FKO established the Helping Families Fundraising Gala, an annual giving event where all proceeds directly benefit children in need. Since its inception in 2008, the Helping Families Fundraising Gala has helped over 250 children access afterschool programs. This year, in celebration of our 35th Anniversary, we are committed to fundraising \$60,000 – our most substantial amount yet – which will connect up to 50 low-income children with safe, quality afterschool services.

### The issue at-hand.

More than 200,000 Massachusetts children are home alone when school is out because their parents can't afford the cost of out-of-school time services. 35 years ago, FKO first tackled this issue when we opened our doors to care for five children in a church basement – supporting working families and keeping their children safe during the afterschool hours.

Today, nearly 2,000 children – many of whom are from low-income families, have special needs or have experiences trauma in their young lives – enjoy our programs each year. While this growth is exciting, there's still more work to be done as hundreds of children remain on the waitlist for subsidized care across the communities we serve. This need far exceeds the funding available.

- 81% of Massachusetts parents say afterschool programs help them keep their jobs.
- 66% of Massachusetts parents say afterschool programs excite kids about learning.
- 73% of Massachusetts parents say afterschool reduces the likelihood that kids will engage in risky behavior.
