CLASS	DESCRIPTION
The Sketchbook Society	Love to draw—or want to get better at it? In Drawing Club, you'll learn how to draw all kinds of characters, from heroes and villains to funny and fantastic creations. You'll practice new skills, try cool drawing challenges, and build your own drawing portfolio. At the end, your artwork will be displayed at our next family event—just like a real art show!
Lights, Camera, FUN!	You'll team up with other students to create characters, plan scenes, and write a script for an original movie. Together, you'll decide what happens, who the characters are, and how the story ends. Then, your finished movie will be shared with families at our next event—just like a real movie premiere!
Battle of the Brains	Ready, set, think! In this exciting club, students put their knowledge to the test in friendly trivia competitions. From science and history to pop culture and brain teasers, members team up, solve challenges, and see who comes out on top. It's all about learning, laughing, and celebrating curiosity!
Twist & Thread	In this hands-on club, students will learn how to turn string into awesome bracelets and necklaces. We'll start with easy knots and twists, then level up to cool braiding styles like three-strand, fishtail, and round braids. As skills grow, students will mix in color patterns and beads to design jewelry that's totally their own. Along the way, students will practice patience, problem-solving, and fine motor skills while creating wearable art they can show off and share!
Sports Mash-Up!	In Sports mash-up, you'll get to play games, try different sports, and challenge yourself in a fun and supportive environment. You can work with teammates, practice new skills, or try something you've never done before. The focus is on having fun, staying active, and enjoying sports in a friendly way!
The Story Studio	In this club, students dive into books and manga, exploring exciting stories and unforgettable characters. After reading, they get to unleash their creativity by writing or designing alternate endings, imagining "what could happen next?" It's a hands-on, fun way to read, think critically, and bring their own stories to life!
The Dance Lab	In The Dance Lab, kids watch the hottest Just Dance videos on YouTube and follow along, learning fun routines while staying active. It's a playful mix of music appreciation, coordination, and pure joy—no judgment, no pressure, just dancing, smiling, and letting loose with friends. Think of it as screen time that gets them moving, shaking, and loving every beat!
Expression Lab	On Fridays, students get to participate in fun enrichment experiences shaped by their own interests and choices. Activities are developed in partnership with students, allowing them to help guide the content and structure while encouraging imagination, creativity, and self-expression. Weekly lessons are intentionally connected, building on prior learning and skills as students work toward a culminating project selected by the group. This collaborative approach provides opportunities for students to explore personal interests, work alongside peers, and reflect at the end of the week in a supportive environment.
