ENRICHMENT CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

CLASS	DESCRIPTION
Mini Scientists	Kids become real “scientists” as they perform simple, hands-on experiments each week. They make predictions, test ideas, observe what happens, and record results with drawings or words. Every experiment is safe, fast, and super visual – perfect for young kids and easy for you to run in a gym/cafeteria/library.
Our Big Book	Kids work together to create one large scrapbook that represents their group. Each week they add a new page or spread based on a fun theme. They contribute drawings, photos, quotes, stickers, and small crafts. The book grows week by week until it becomes a huge keepsake full of memories, art, and teamwork.
Story Explorers	Each week, you read a short story and do a fun activity connected to it (draw a character, act it out, find mystery clues from the story, make a “storybook bookmark”). Super easy and sparks a love for reading.
Mini Olympics	Kids compete in kid-friendly “Olympic-style” events each week. You can do individual and team challenges so everyone gets a chance to shine
Once upon a puppet	Kids work together to write, design, and perform a puppet show. Over several weeks, they build puppets, create characters, plan scenes, and practice performing. The final session is a puppet theater performance for classmates, teachers, or parents. It’s hands-on, creative, collaborative, and boosts confidence, storytelling, and social skills.
Sports Skills Club	The Sports Skills Club keeps kids moving with fun dribbling challenges, mini soccer games, flag football basics, and exciting races. Children build coordination, strength, and teamwork while learning fundamental sports skills in a positive, high-energy environment.
Brains and Games	Introduce children to fun board games that build critical thinking, planning, and problem-solving skills. Children learn game strategies and practice applying them while playing together, helping them develop patience, cooperation, and smart decision-making.
The Pod Squad	Children will explore storytelling, creativity, and communication by creating their own podcasts. Members plan episodes, record voices, and share ideas while learning how to express themselves and work as a team. It’s a fun way to build confidence, creativity, and tech skills.
Tinker Town	Children experience engineering through hands-on projects and creative challenges. Kids design, build, and test their own inventions using a variety of materials, learning problem-solving and teamwork along the way. It’s a playful way to spark curiosity, critical thinking, and a love for building.
