# ENRICHMENT CLASS SCHEDULE

CLASS	DESCRIPTION
Folklore and Fables	Students will create their own characters, act out mini-scenes, design simple story props, and even try inventing their own fables. It's a playful mix of imagination, culture, and creativity that helps build confidence, comprehension, and a love of stories.
Art Around the World	Each week, kids "visit" a new region through stories, images, and music, then create their own art inspired by what they've learned—like African pattern weaving, Japanese ink painting, Mexican folk art, Australian Aboriginal dot designs, and more!
Team Builders	Working in small teams, kids tackle STEM and creative challenges that build teamwork, communication, and problem-solving skills.
Microscopic Adventures	Young scientists will explore the hidden world all around them using real microscopes. They'll investigate plants, pond life, and everyday objects while observing, sketching, and sharing discoveries.
Kid Staff	In this hands-on leadership-and-creativity club, students get to step into the role of "Kid Staff"! Each week, an adult leader will demonstrate a new craft and teach one or two students the steps behind the scenes. Those "Kid Staff" then take the lead—guiding the group, explaining steps, handing out materials, and helping their peers bring the project to life!
Animal Adventures	Students will learn about creatures from the jungle, ocean, forest, and even their own backyard. Kids will participate in hands on activities like creating animal crafts, solving creature-themed challenges, exploring animal habits
Food Fun	In this hands on enrichment students will turn craft materials into mouth watering foods. Kids will make pretend foods like pizza snacks and desserts no oven required.
Around the House	Students will dive into creative activities inspired by different rooms and objects around the house. Students will discover how much imagination lives right at home.
Fantasy Fun Week	Students will partake in a variety of activities such as designing their own fantasy characters, building miniature enchanted worlds, solving wizardly challenges and bringing their stories to life.
Discovering Artist	Students will discover famous artists from the around the world - past, and present. Students will learn about artistic styles, practice creative problem-solving, and express themselves through a variety of materials.
