# ENRICHMENT CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

CLASS	DESCRIPTION
Piano Club	Children will learn how to play the piano by practicing a specific song. Through this process, they will be introduced to musical notes, learn how to read a simple music sheet, and memorize the piano keys. Lessons will focus on building foundational music skills while encouraging confidence and enjoyment in playing the piano.
Origami Club	Students will learn the art of origami by following step-by-step instructions to fold paper into various shapes and figures. Through this process, they will develop fine motor skills, spatial awareness, patience, and creativity while learning to follow directions and problem-solve.
Draw Club	Children will learn how to use a variety of art materials—including oil pastels, paint, pencils, and markers—to create drawings and artwork. Through guided practice and exploration, students will develop their artistic skills, experiment with different techniques, and build confidence in their creative expression.
Jewelry Club	Children will explore jewelry design through different shapes, patterns, and colors. Students will learn how to create bracelets, necklaces, earrings, and other jewelry pieces while practicing measurement, pattern-making, and color coordination.
Animal Club	Children will learn about different animals each week, focusing on where they are from, their habitat, their predators, and build activities around that animal.
Nail Club	Children will learn basic nail care and nail art techniques in a fun, safe, and creative environment. Students will practice designing and decorating nails using child-safe materials while developing fine motor skills, creativity, and self-expression.
Jewelry Club	Children will explore jewelry from a different culture each week. They will learn about the cultural meaning, materials, patterns, and symbols used in that culture's jewelry. After the lesson, students will design and create their own jewelry inspired by what they learned.
Mad Scientist Club	Children will explore basic science concepts through hands-on experiments and exciting activities. By acting like "mad scientists," students will learn to ask questions, make predictions, and discover how things work in a fun, safe, and creative environment.
Arts & Crafts Club	Children will explore a variety of arts and crafts activities using different materials and techniques. Through hands-on projects, students will develop creativity, fine motor skills, and confidence while expressing their ideas in a fun and supportive environment.
