# ENRICHMENT CLASS SCHEDULE

CLASS	DESCRIPTION
Art Around the world	The goal of Art Around the World is to introduce students to diverse cultures through hands-on art experiences inspired by countries from around the globe. Students will explore how art reflects traditions, history, and daily life while expressing their own creativity. The club promotes cultural appreciation, creativity, and collaboration in a fun and age-appropriate way.
DIY Club	DIY Club is a hands-on creative club where students design, build, and create projects using craft supplies, recycled materials, and simple tools. Students are encouraged to use their imagination and try new ideas while having fun. The goal of DIY Club is to support creativity, independence, and problem-solving by allowing students to explore how things are made and express their ideas through hands-on projects.
Animal Adventure	The goal of Animal Adventure is to spark students' curiosity about animals from around the world. Each week, students will explore a different animal or habitat while learning about animal characteristics, needs, behaviors, and how humans can help protect animals. Through hands-on activities, crafts, games, and discussions, students will build knowledge, empathy, and a love for animals and nature.
Friendship Club	The goal of Friendship Club is to help students build positive relationships and develop social-emotional skills in a safe and supportive environment. Students will learn what it means to be a good friend through games, discussions, role-play, and collaborative activities. The club encourages kindness, empathy, inclusion, and respectful communication.
Brian Nine the science guy	The goal of Brian Nine the Science Guy is to spark curiosity and excitement about science through hands-on experiments, demonstrations, and inquiry-based learning. Students explore basic science concepts in a fun, engaging way while learning to ask questions, make predictions, and discover how science connects to everyday life.
Book Club	The goal of Book Club is to build a love for reading while strengthening literacy and communication skills. Students will explore age-appropriate books through read-alouds, discussions, and creative response activities. The club encourages listening, sharing ideas, and making connections to stories in a fun and supportive environment.
Diamond Art	The goal of Diamond Art Club is to help students build focus, patience, and creativity through diamond art projects. Students will follow patterns to place small gems while creating colorful designs. The club supports fine motor development and self-expression while encouraging students to take pride in completing a project from start to finish.

CLASS	DESCRIPTION
Winter Craft & Creation Club	Step into a world of winter wonder! In the Winter Craft & Creation Club, students will explore a variety of hands-on art and craft projects inspired by the magic of the season. From creating sparkling snowflakes and frosty decorations to designing cozy winter-themed gifts and DIY ornaments, this club encourages creativity, imagination, and fine motor skill development.
Scrapbook Club	Scrapbook Club is a creative club where students use photos, drawings, stickers, and craft materials to create scrapbook pages. Students will tell stories, share memories, and design pages that reflect their interests and experiences. The goal of Scrapbook Club is to encourage self-expression and creativity while helping students organize their thoughts and tell stories through art.
Life is Good/ CPS Teacher	Fun team-building games, relays, and challenges that help kids practice teamwork, cheering for friends, and staying active.
Physical Education/ CPS Teacher	Active games and sports like soccer, kickball, and basketball that build teamwork, strength, and cooperation.
Creative Art/ CPS Teacher	Creative projects using paint, clay, markers, and collage supplies to explore colors, shapes, and techniques while making unique artwork.
Robotics & Coding/ CPS Teacher	STEM challenges with building, robotics, and coding where students test ideas, program simple codes, and bring creations to life.
